Check in at Omaha's Eppley Airfield mid-day for the first leg of the overnight trans-Atlantic flight to London. Meal service and movie in flight.

For transportation throughout your stay (including free time), each tour member will receive a London Oyster Travel Card good for excellent public transit all over London. Saturday, February 18

After continental breakfast, make plans for which London experience will be yours to enjoy on your own. In the afternoon, we will meet at the National Theatre for a backstage tour followed by an evening performance—one of our highlights each year.

Sunday, February 19

After breakfast the day is yours to do those last minute things you don't want to miss before we gather for a farewell fish and chips dinner at the London landmark, Rock and Sole Plaice.

Monday, February 20

Part of our group will return home today. The rest of us will travel by motor coach for this year's Optional Tour Extension to Liverpool and Glasgow!
